Identifying the function

Jerry Webster uses a simple acronym:

ABC (Antecedent-Behavior-Consequence)

to define the three basic parts of behaviour.

- **Antecedent:** The environment
- **Behaviour:** What the student actually does
- **Consequence:** Everything that happens after...

The clearest evidence of how a behaviour functions for a child is seen in the antecedent (A) and the consequence (C.)
